

Key Workers can assist your family in the following ways:

- Being a contact person in relation to Novita services.
- Assisting with understanding, planning and prioritising Novita Services.
- Providing information about Novita services.
- Attending and/or planning meetings.
- Helping with communication between the Novita team members.
- Supporting families.

Do I need a Key Worker?

Key Workers are especially useful for families who are new to Novita and are getting to know Novita services. Children who are transferring from kindy to school, primary school to high school, and leaving Novita services are other groups that may benefit from the help of a Key Worker.

Some families may not need a Key Worker, especially those who are familiar with Novita's services.

Who will be my Key Worker?

Your Key Worker may be your child's physiotherapist, speech pathologist, occupational therapist, psychologist or family services co-ordinator.

What if I don't want a Key worker?

No worries. You do not have to have a Key worker if you don't want one.
