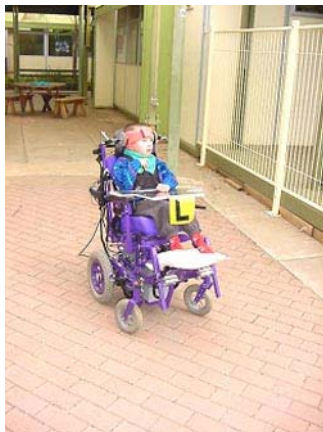


MY WONDERFUL DRIVING

Mrs Verner helps me get ready for my driving lesson.

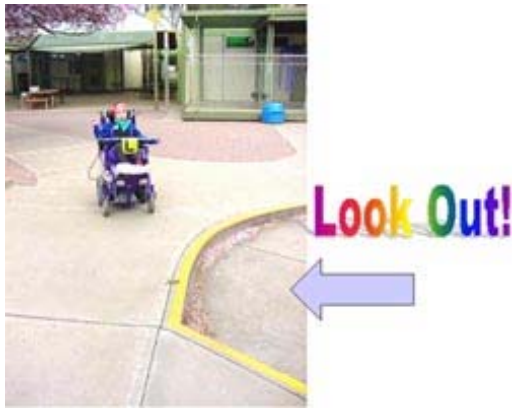


I find the switch on my chest and off I go!
