

REGISTRATION - \$650 PER CREW MEMBER

- 5 night's camping accommodation (participants need to bring own bedding and sleeping gear – i.e. swags).
 Upgrading to motel / cabin style accommodation is available at own cost.

All boats must be registered for the duration of the 2022 event and the vessel needs to be at least 4m in length and capable of cruising at a minimum of 30km/h in mild conditions.
